Born on July 20, 1947, in St. James, Trinidad & Tobago, West Indies, Deacon Winston A. Stewart lived a life marked by devotion, compassion, and unwavering strength. He departed this world on November 3, 2025, leaving behind a legacy that will continue to inspire all who knew him.

The beloved son of Phillip Stewart and Drucilla Dover, both now departed, Winston began his journey at Mt. Lambert RC Elementary School and Tranquility High School in Trinidad. In the late 1980s, he courageously moved to the United States, where he furthered his education in Brooklyn, NY, and built a life rooted in service and faith.
